

What is an Urban Food Policy




A Food Policy is a support tool to the city government: it defines, addresses and shapes the policies and the actions that are linked to the many dimensions of food in the city















A pact between important cities around the world to promote food systems that are based on principles of sustainability and social justice




It is promoted by the City of Milan together with about 120 cities and an Advisory Group composed by Fondazione Cariplo and international institutions and foundations




